

Adjectives

An adjective is used to give more description to nouns.

Example:

A man drove a car.

Which man? What kind of car?

A young man drove a red car.

Combining adjectives:

A tanned, young man drove a shiny, new, red car.

Adjectives after the verb “to be”:

The man is young. The car was red. His new car will be red.

Making adjectives out of nouns:

The sun is out today. The weather is sunny.

Making adjectives out of verbs:

The red car shines. It is a shiny car.
